The City Council of the City of Manly, Iowa met in special session in City Hall Council Chambers on Monday January 22, 2018. The meeting was called to order a 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Badker. Mayor Badker asked for approval of the agenda. Motion by Durgin to approve the agenda, second by Banks, and approved unanimously.

Budget Workshop FY '19 – Financial Discussions

1. Discuss and take action on meeting compensation for Council Members

No increase in compensation for council member meetings has taken place since 2002. Motion by Ryan to increase Council Members and Mayor council meeting pay to \$65.00 per meeting, second by Banks and approved unanimously. Pay for special meetings will remain at \$25.00 per meeting.

2. Discuss and take action on pay increase for city employees

Motion by Banks to approve a five percent pay increase for employees, second by Durgin. Ayes: Heagel, Banks, Durgin and Behrends. Nays: Ryan. Moving forward the council will begin merit raises for employees for the next fiscal year.

3. Discuss and take action on Police Department Budget

Talked about was the current police budget and contract with the Worth County Sheriff's Department for calls covered in Manly when necessary. No action taken at this time.

4. Discuss and take action on phone allowance for Mayor

Motion by Durgin to approve a thirty dollar monthly phone allowance for Mayor Badker, second by Behrends and approved unanimously.

5. Discuss and take action on phone allowance for Assistant Public Works Director

Motion by Ryan to approve a \$15.00 monthly phone allowance for Logan Butler, second by Banks and approved unanimously.

6. Discuss and take action on council pay for the City Clerk

Motion by Durgin to set an amount of \$45.00 per meeting for the City Clerk effective January 22, 2018, second by Behrends and approved unanimously.

7. Fire Truck Loan

Motion by Ryan to move forward with the loan for the fire truck, second by Banks and approved unanimously.
