REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Monday, May 15, 2017
7:00 P.M.

The City Council of the City of Manly, Iowa met in regular session in City Hall Council Chambers on Monday, May 15, 2017. The meeting was called to order a 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Badker. Council Members present were: Heagel, Banks, Durgin Leake and Ryan. City Attorney, Officer Curoe and many residents of Manly were also in attendance.

Mayor Badker asked for approval of the agenda. Motion by Ryan to approve the agenda, second by Durgin and approved unanimously. Mayor Badker asked for approval of the Consent Agenda, including routine items, minutes of the regular meeting on May 1, 2017, claims paid from May 1, 2017 through May 15, 2017, per Resolution 2012-07, approval of claims to be paid from May 1, 2017 through May 15, 2017, Treasurer's and Budget Reports through May 15, 2017 and Police Stats for April, 2017. NEW BUSINESS

1. Clarification and take possible action on funding mechanism for purchase of excavator

Council Member Banks informed the council he had talked to city attorney Tom Meyer regarding this item to be placed on the agenda and also announced he would like to review the procedures of repayment to the sewer fund for the excavator. Discussion was held regarding repayment and revenues previously credited towards the total purchase along with the estimate to renovate the first project. Motion by Banks to repay the sewer fund \$34,000.00 over a five year period from the L.O.S.T. fund, second by Leake. Ayes: Banks, Durgin, Leake and Ryan. Nays: Heagel

2. Ordinance 75.01 - All - Terrain Vehicles

Motion by Leake to pass the first reading of amendment to Ordinance 75.01, second by Heagel. Roll vote as follows: Heagel - Aye, Banks - Aye, Durgin - Aye, Leake - Aye, Ryan - Aye.

3. Mosquito Spraying

Discussion was held regarding the shared mosquito sprayer with the City of Grafton. Both cities are going with Mosquito Control of Iowa. The company has offered to buy back the sprayer and chemicals both cities have previously purchased. Motion by Heagel to split revenues received equally with Grafton, second by Leake and approved unanimously.

4. Aquatic Center

Regan Banks, pool committee member spoke regarding pool hours for the 2017 season. The opening day of the 2017 season will be Sunday, May 28th, opening at 1:00PM and closing at 8:00 PM. The following summer hours are set as follows: Monday - Thursday, opening at 1:00PM and closing to the public at 7:00 PM. Friday - Sunday, opening at 1:00PM and closing at 8:00 PM. Adult lap swim as follows: Monday - Thursday, beginning at 7:00 PM to 8:00 PM and adding Tuesdays only for an additional Adult lap swim from 11:30-12:30 PM. Council Member Banks also discussed supplies needed such as a time clock and some minor renovations to bring the concession to state compliance for the food sales. Motion by Heagel to approve purchases required for the pool, second by Ryan and approved unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:21 P.M.
