****CHANGES TO GARBAGE PICKUP****

Garbage pickup is still Tuesdays. Due to a route change all garbage needs to be curbside by 8am and tied securely. If bags are not tied or closed they will not be picked up. If the garbage truck has went by your residence you will have to remove from curb and wait until the next week. Please do not put toxic items in the bags (example motor oil, etc.). Garbage bags can be purchased at Pronto Gas Station or Casey's General Store.

Per City of Manly Code:

REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS.

It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a residential property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within forty-eight (48) hours, or a commercial or industrial property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within twenty-four (24) hours, the City may do so and assess the costs against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax. (Code of Iowa 364.12[2b & e])

UTILITY METERS must be accessible. Please ensure that a path is cleared to the readout (black plastic box or oval) located on the outside of your house. Accessibility to the meters is essential for an actual utility meter reading.

ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING went into effect on November 15th 2017 and will run thru March 31, 2018. City Ordinance 69.10 SNOW EMERGENCY is posted on our website at www.cityofmanly.net.

WITH WINTER WEATHER - Please do not discard snow and ice onto city streets. Tickets may be issued for violations of city code.
