Their mission is to ensure that every baby in America has enough diapers to remain clean, dry and healthy. How they work to achieve this goal is to educate the public on a national scale, to support and expand upon the number of diaper banks across America and to build national corporate partnerships to supply the network with bulk donations and bulk purchasing of diapers.

Diapers given to this diaper drive will be delivered directly to the New Beginnings House of Hope in Mason City, IA; a 30 day-temporary women/children homeless shelter that is part of the Northern Lights Alliance for the Homeless. It can serve up to 26 women along with their children.

Drop off locations are at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Manly, Grace Lutheran Church in Hanlontown, and at the Manly Public Library. The diaper drive accepts diapers in any size or brand. Wipes can be included as well.

## Per City of Manly Code:

### REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS.

It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a residential property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within forty-eight (48) hours, or a commercial or industrial property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within twenty-four (24) hours, the City may do so and assess the costs against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax. (Code of Iowa 364.12[2b & e])

**UTILITY METERS** must be accessible. Please ensure that a path is cleared to the readout (black plastic box or oval) located on the outside of your house. Accessibility to the meters is essential for an actual utility meter reading.

**ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING** went into effect on November 15<sup>th</sup> 2016 and will run thru March 31, 2017. City Ordinance 69.10 SNOW EMERGENCY is posted on our website at [www.cityofmanly.net](http://www.cityofmanly.net).

**WITH WINTER WEATHER** - Please do not discard snow and ice onto city streets. Tickets may be issued for violations of city code.
