TREE BRANCHES & BRUSH MUST BE CURBSIDE BY 7:00 AM IN BUNDLES NOT OVER 4qLONG OR MORE THAN 18+IN DIAMETER TIED WITH TWINE OR STRING, NO WIRE. NO BRANCHES OR BRUSH OVER 4qEACH IN DIAMETER. GRASS RAKINGS & LEAVES WILL BE PICKED UP IN DEGRADABLE PAPER BAGS ONLY. BAGS SHALL NOT BE MORE THAN 30 GALLON CAPACITY, 2 PLY 50 LB. WET STRENGTH.
