## **Per City of Manly Code:**

### **REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS.**

It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a residential property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within forty-eight (48) hours, or a commercial or industrial property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within twenty-four (24) hours, the City may do so and assess the costs against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax.
