OPEN BURNING RESTRICTED – As of February 17, 2015 – **No open burning** of landscape waste, or any combustible material is allowed in the city limits. Any violation of this code shall be punishable by a \$200 fine for the first offense and a \$350 fine each time after. City Dump is now open for yard waste only.

SPRING CLEAN UP APRIL 24, 2017

This year the City will be providing a dumpster that will be located down at the City Shed at 228 N. East Street. The dumpster will be available from Monday, April 24th thru Friday, April 28th. Residents who have prepaid for their junk/large items will be responsible for getting their junk/large items to the dumpster. If help is needed to unload junk/large items at the dumpster City employees can be contacted during work hours to help unload.

Fire departments across the country undergo a rating by the Insurance Services Office (I.S.O) approximately every four years. I.S.O. evaluates four primary categories to determine Cities rating. Those categories consist of the Fire Department, Emergency Communication, Water Supply and Community Risk Reduction. The City of Manly I.S.O. rating has improved with a rating of 4.4. The Insurance Services Office automatically generates this information to insurance companies regarding cities rate changes as it reflects a decrease in premiums. However, if homeowners have questions you are encouraged to check with your homeowners insurance company.
