WINTER WEATHER IS UPON US – it is unlawful for any person to throw, push, or place or cause to be thrown, pushed or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways on to the traveled way of a street or alley so as to obstruct gutter, or impede to impede the passage of vehicles upon the street or alley or to create a hazardous condition therein; except where, in the cleaning of large commercial drives in the business district it is absolutely necessary to move the snow onto the street or alley temporarily, such accumulation shall be removed promptly by the property owner or agent. Arrangements for the prompt removal of such accumulations shall be made prior to moving the snow. Please do not discard snow and ice onto city streets. Tickets will be issued for violations of city code. Per City of Manly Code: **REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS. It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations promptly from sidewalks.** If a residential property owner does not remove snow or ice accumulations within forty-eight (48) hours, or a commercial or industrial property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within twenty-four (24) hours, the City may do so and assess the cost against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax. (Code of Iowa 364.12[2b&e])

UTILITY METERS must be accessible. Please ensure that a path is cleared to the readout (black plastic box or oval) located on the outside of your house. Accessibility to the meters is essential for an actual utility meter reading.
