## DATES TO REMEMBER - Leaf & Limb Pickup: November 14<sup>th</sup>

Tree branches & brush must be curbside by 7:00am. Bundles not over 4qlong or more than 18+in diameter tied with twine or string, no wire. No branches or brush over 4qeach in diameter. Grass rakings & leaves will be picked up in degradable paper bags only. Bags shall not be more than 30 gallon capacity, 2ply 50lb wet strength.

**WINTER WEATHER APPROACHING –** please do not discard snow and ice onto city streets. Tickets will be issued for violations of city code. Per City of Manly Code: REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS. It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. If a residential property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within forty-eight (48) hours, or a commercial or industrial property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumulations within twenty-four (24) hours, the City may do so and assess the cost against the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax. (Code of Iowa 364.12[2b&e]) **UTILITY METERS** must be accessible. Please ensure that a path is cleared to the readout (black plastic box or oval) located on the outside of your house. Accessibility to the meters is essential for an actual utility meter reading.

**ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING –** goes into effect November 15, 2018 thru March 31, 2019.
